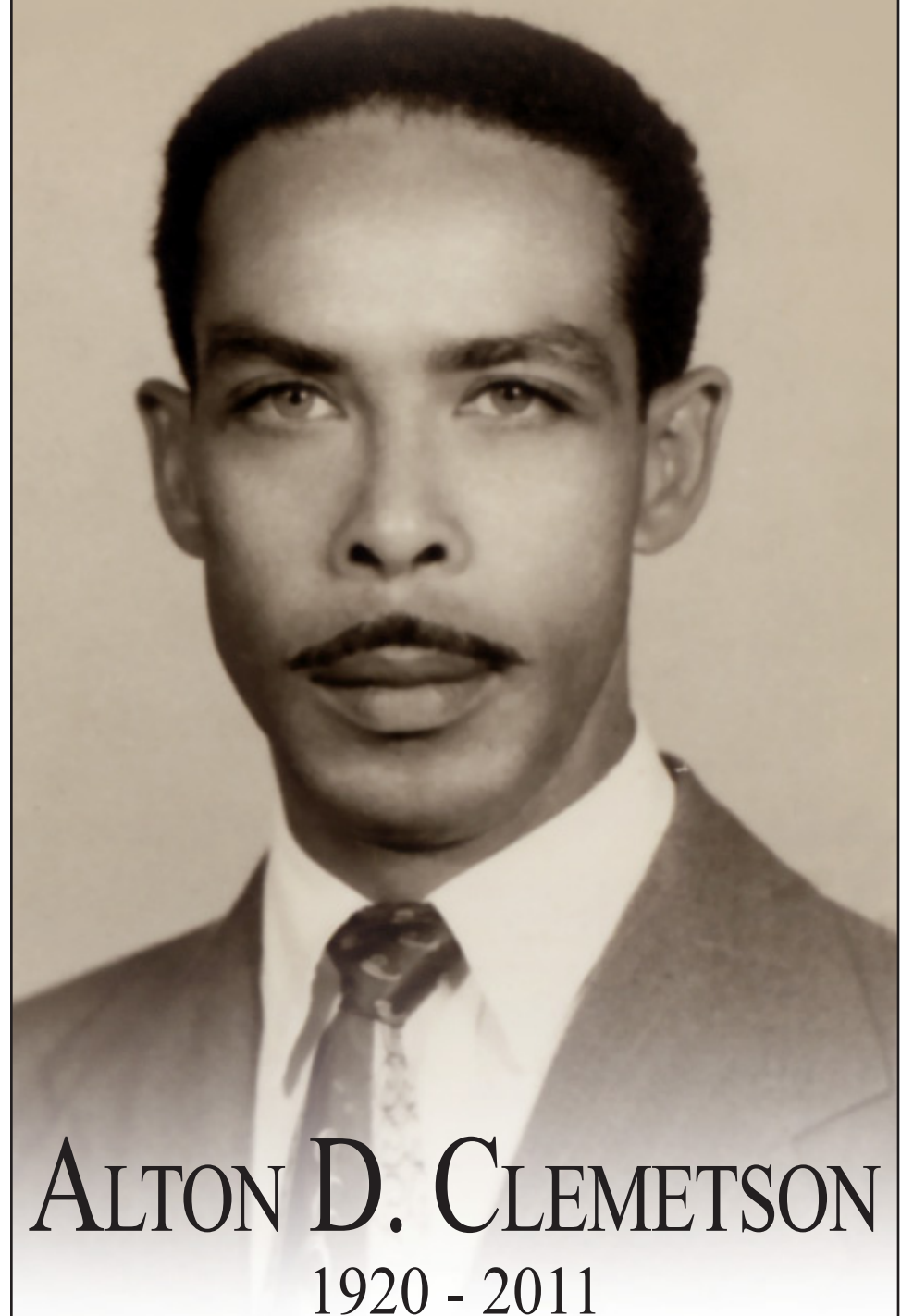

Obituary

Alton Donavon Clemetson, also known as "Jack", was born on September 29, 1920 in Kingston, Jamaica to the union of Abraham and Vera Clemetson.

Alton Clemetson attended school at Calabar High School in Jamaica. He then went on to agriculture school and then joined the Royal Air Force in 1943 at the age of 23, in which he served as a sharp shooter in WWII. Also while in the Royal Air Force, he met his wife Pauline Passmore who was in the Woman's Auxiliary Army Corps. The couple united in holy matrimony in 1945. To this union two daughters were born, Sandra and Roxanna Clemetson.

Alton worked at the Jamaica Tobacco Company located on Waterloo Road, as the manager of the wrapping department. He then went on to start his own business of raising and selling Quails. His business also specialized in selling pickled Quail eggs.

He then moved to Cleveland, Ohio in 1986 with his daughter, Sandra and granddaughter, Shanequa. Alton went on to become a security guard at the Cleveland Municipality Stadium, guarding the players locker rooms. He retired from working security at the age of 84.

Alton will forever be remembered by his daughter, Roxanna Clemetson and granddaughter, Shanequa Niles, along with countless other friends and family. He has gone on to join his wife, Pauline Passmore and daughter, Sandra McFarlane. He will also be joining his mother and father, as well as his brother, Trevor and sister, Joy.
